> **DECLARING THE COMMERCIAL OPERATION OF ENHANCED** WHOLESALE ELECTRICITY SPOT MARKET (WESM) DESIGN AND **OPERATIONS (EWDO) AND PROVIDING FURTHER POLICIES**

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WHEREAS, Section 30 and 37 of the Electric Power Industry Reform Act of 2001 ("EPIRA") provides that the Department of Energy ("DOE"), jointly with the electric power industry participants, shall establish the WESM and formulate the detailed rules governing the operations thereof;

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WHEREAS, the DOE, on 28 June 2002, pursuant to its mandate, in consultation with the electric power industry participants, promulgated Department Circular ("DC") 2002-06-0003 or the WESM Rules and established the WESM;

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WHEREAS, the DOE, on 23 October 2015, issued DC 2015-10-0015 providing the policies for further enhancement of the WESM Design and Operations;

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WHEREAS, the DOE, on 04 May 2017, issued the DC 2017-05-0009 "Declaring the Launch of the WESM in Mindanao and Providing for Transition Guidelines" effective 26 June 2017 to provide sufficient time for the Market Operator ("MO"), System Operator ("SO") and WESM Participants to prepare and familiarize themselves in WESM operations;

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WHEREAS, the Energy Regulatory Commission (ERC), on 20 August 2020, approved the Price Determination Methodology for the EWDO;

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37 38 WHEREAS, on --- May 2021, the Philippine Electricity Market Corporation submitted to the DOE a certification on the readiness of the Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao Grids to the implementation of EWDO based on readiness criteria pursuant to DC2017-05-0009; and

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WHEREAS, the conditions for the commercial operation of EWDO in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao have been met however, the DOE deemed it necessary to provide additional support to ensure efficient transition of the Trading Participants.

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NOW, THEREFORE, from the foregoing premises and pursuant to its authority under the EPIRA and the WESM Rules, the DOE hereby adopts, issues, and promulgates the following:

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Section 1. **Declaration of Commercial Operation Date of the EWDO.** The DOE As for WESM Mindanao, the MO, SO and the Governance Arm shall submit their evaluation of the LLDO, with recommendation if another Commercial Operation Date is necessary, to the DOE for its evaluation and approval not later than five (5) days from the Commercial Operation Date.

Section 2. Relaxation of Prudential Requirements ("PR"). The posting of PR shall be relaxed for the first three (3) months from the Commercial Operation Date of EWDO in Mindanao. For this purpose, the following shall be observed:

2.1. The Mindanao WESM Trading Participants shall be allowed to post the required PR within three (3) months from the Commercial Operation Date.

2.2. For each of the spot transactions during the period of relaxation of the posting of PR as stated in Section 2.1, the concerned Mindanao WESM Trading Participants shall ensure timely settlement of its monthly bills with the MO. Otherwise, interest shall apply in accordance with the applicable provisions of WESM Rules and Market Manuals.

2.3. Prior to the lapse of the three (3) month relaxation period, the Mindanao Trading Participants who may not be able to post the required PR may opt to change its registration status to Indirect WESM Membership and transact in the WESM through its Direct WESM Member counterparty. Otherwise, applicable sanctions and/or penalties shall be imposed in accordance with the applicable provisions of WESM Rules and Market Manuals.

Section 3. Relaxation of Compliance to Dispatch Conformance Standards. The compliance to Dispatch Conformance Standards shall be relaxed for the first three (3) months from Commercial Operation Date of EWDO in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. For this purpose:

3.1. The WESM Trading Participants in Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao shall be exempted from sanctions and penalties in case of breach of Dispatch Conformance Standards provided under the WESM Dispatch protocol during the first three (3) months of the commercial operation of EWDO. Notwithstanding, the Enforcement and Compliance Office (ECO) shall continue to monitor the observance of Dispatch Conformance Standards by the Trading Participants for the purpose of evaluation of the initial commercial operation of EWDO.

All Trading Participants shall ensure full compliance to all other obligations under the WESM Rules and Market Manuals.

3.2. Upon the lapse of the three (3) month period, the Trading Participants shall ensure full compliance to Dispatch Conformance Standards in accordance with the applicable provisions of WESM Rules and Market Manuals.

Section 4. Assignment of Metering Service Provider (MSP) for Embedded Generators. The host Distribution Utility (DU) of Embedded Generators may provide metering services to Embedded Generators operating within their franchise area subject to authorization by the ERC. Provided, that the DU acting as MSP shall ensure compliance to the applicable provisions of the WESM Rules and Market Manuals to include metering standards and timely submission of metering data among others. Provided, further, that upon their registration to the WESM, the DU-MSP shall be regularly subject to the conduct of MSP audit undertaken by the PEM Audit Committee.
Section 5. Compliance to WESM Registration. Subject to Section 2, all Trading Participants shall ensure completion of their WESM registration prior to Commercial Operation Date. Otherwise, applicable sanctions and/or penalties shall be imposed in accordance with the applicable provisions of WESM Rules and Market Manuals and other relevant issuances of the DOE.
Section 6. Regulatory Support. The ERC shall ensure the provision of support in the regulatory requirements and approvals consistent with the policies set forth under this Circular and in accordance with existing laws and procedures. It shall impose benalties for any violation to this Circular.
Section 7. Separability. If any provision of this Circular is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain valid and subsisting.
Section 8. Repealing Clause. All issuances inconsistent with the provisions of this Circular are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.
Section 9. Effectivity. This Circular shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation. Copies thereof shall be filed with the University of the Philippines Law Center – Office of National Administrative Register (UPLC-ONAR).
