SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF FIVE (5) UNITS MOTOR VEHICLES FOR OIMB FOR CY2024

- 1. The **Department of Energy (DOE)** intends to procure **Supply and Delivery of Five (5) Units of Motor Vehicles for OIMB** with an Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of Thirteen Million Nine Hundred Thirty Thousand Pesos (Php13,930,000.00).
- 2. The **DOE Bids and Award Committee (DOE-BAC)** now invites technically, legally, and financially capable suppliers for the said project.
- 3. The Procurement procedure for this requirement is **Negotiated Procurement** for Two-Failed Bidding (AMP 53.1) pursuant to Section 53.1 of 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.
 - The selection of the successful offer shall be based on the best and final offer that will be submitted on the set deadline by the BAC and which would meet the minimum technical specifications required.
- 4. The interested bidders may obtain further information from the BAC Secretariat at the address given below from **17 July 2024** to **23 July 2024**, Monday to Friday, at 8:00AM to 4:00PM.
- 5. The **DOE** will hold a Negotiation Meeting on **19 July 2024 at 10:00AM** at **OIMB Conference Room**, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
- 6. Two (2) copies of the proposals (one original and one copy) must be submitted to the BAC which must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address indicated above on or before **3:00 PM of 23**June 2024. Late submission shall not be accepted.
- 7. Interested bidders shall submit the following documents in sealed envelopes, labeled as "Negotiated Procurement for Two-Failed Biddings", with the title of the procurement project, name of the bidder, address, the contact details of the bidder, addressed to the BAC.

In case of Joint Venture, Special Power of Attorney shall be submitted by all members of the joint venture giving full power and authority to its officer to sign the OSS and do acts to represent the Bidder.
- g) If applicable, a duly signed joint venture agreement (JVA) in case the joint venture is already in existence or duly notarized statement from all the potential joint venture partners stating that they will enter into and abide by the provisions of the JVA in the instance that the bid is successful.

A. TENDER OF BID

- 1. The technical bid should include manufacturer's name, address and relevant technical literature/brochure/manual with warranty terms for the cab, chassis, suspension, engine, powertrain, brake system, electrical system and its accessories.
- 2. The Supplier shall have available service center within 50 Km from DOE-Main Office and Field Offices.

B. WARRANTY/AFTERSALES

- 3. Vehicle warranty of (3) years or 100kms travel distance whichever comes first which shall commence upon signing of Acceptance Certificate. Supplier should warrant that all vehicle, components, and accessories are new, according to the specifications and free from defects, and warranties cover the following: cab, chassis, suspension, engine, powertrain, brake and electrical systems and its accessories. The defects, if any, shall be rectified or replaced free of charge.
- 4. Free labor and materials for 1000 and 5000 km preventive maintenance services (PMS).

C. DELIVERY/PAYMENT

- 5. Five (5) units of brand-new Motor Service Vehicle (Van) including the set of tools and early warning device should be delivered to the DOE-Main Office at Taguig, Metro Manila within 180 calendar days from receipt of purchase order. Vehicle registration and GSIS comprehensive insurance should be delivered 30 calendar days after the date of delivery.
- 6. Certificate of acceptance/completion will be issued by the end-user upon satisfying the following conditions:
