Resolution No. 433 s. 2023

A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING THE AWARD OF CONTRACT THROUGH THE USE OF ALTERNATIVE MODE OF PROCUREMENT (AMP), FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF CALIBRATION SERVICE FOR FIFTEEN (15) UNITS OF RESISTANCE TEMPERATURE DETECTOR (RTD) PT100 OF AIR CONDITIONER TESTING FACILITY (ACTF) AND CLOTHES WASHING MACHINE TESTING FACILITY (CWMTF)

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) received a memorandum dated 05 September 2023 from Director Amelia M. De Guzman of the Energy Research Testing and Laboratory Services (ERTLS) requesting the BAC's approval through the use of AMP for the Procurement specifically 53.9 Small Value Procurement for the contract in the amount Forty Two Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Pesos Only (Php42,990.00);

WHEREAS, this procurement has been included in the Department's CY 2023 Annual Procurement Plan approved by the Secretary Raphael P. M. Lotilla;

WHEREAS, Sections 48.1, 53 and 53.9 Rule XVI of the 2016 Revised IRR of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 authorized the conduct of Negotiated Procurement under the AMP, the pertinent provisions of which are quoted as follows:

"Sec. 48.1 Alternative Methods. — Subject to the prior approval of the Head of the Procuring Entity, and whenever justified by the conditions provided in this Act, the Procuring Entity may, in order to promote economy and efficiency, resort to any of the alternative methods of procurement provided in this Rule. In all instances, the procuring entity shall ensure that the most advantageous price for the Government is obtained:

"Sec. 53. Negotiated Procurement is a method of procurement of goods, infrastructure projects and consulting services whereby the procuring entity directly negotiates a contract with a technically, legally, and financially capable supplier, contractor or consultant only in the following cases;

"Sec. 53.9. Small Value Procurement. Procurement of Goods, Infrastructure Projects and Consulting Services, where the amount involved does not exceed the threshold prescribe in Annex "H" of this IRR: Provided, That in case of Goods, the procurement does not fall under Shopping in Section 52 of this IRR"

WHEREAS, except for those with ABCs equal to Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php50,000.00) and below, RFQs shall be posted for a period of three (3) calendar days in the PhilGEPS website, website of the Procuring Entity, if available, and at any conspicuous place reserved for this purpose in the premises of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS, the BAC received three (3) quotations canvassed by the end-user, which were endorsed to the BAC-Technical Working Group (TWG) for evaluation, details of which are as follows;

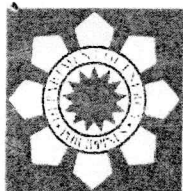
