Supply and delivery of pneumonia vaccine for the DOE personnel health program of the Human Resource Management Division

#### A. 1. FUNCTIONAL DESCRIPTION:

The Pneumonia Vaccine/PCV 13 (Conjugate Pneumococcal Vaccine / 0.5ml pre-filled syringe), being sold by the manufacturer/bidder must be compliant with the Department of Health (DOH) policy, in relation to its National Immunization Program (NIP), particularly implementing/providing the pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV), like the PCV13, as part of its routine immunization initiatives.

The supplier/bidder has passed or must hold an ISO certification or is a DOH accredited entity: e.g.: ISO-9000 (local or international), and has passed or authorized by the Food and Drugs Administration of the DOH, and the Bureau of Products Standards (BPS)-Department of Trade & Industry (DTI).

The Pneumonia Vaccine (PCV13) must be safe, functional that offers a long-lasting protection, based on its medical/chemical components/structure according to the Philippine National Drug Formulary as provided for by Executive Order No. 49 (1993), "Directing the Mandatory Use of the PNDF Volume 1 in the Procurement and Requisition of Drugs and Medicines."

#### B. 2. PERFORMANCE DESCRIPTION:

The PCV13 is expected to protect people against the disease caused by the streptococcus pneumoniae, such as pneumonia, meningitis, and sepsis.

The Pneumonia (PCV13) must have an expiration date not earlier than 01 July 2021.

The supplier must submit a Product Certification from Philippine FDA or the product is duly stamped as PASSED by the DOH-FDA.

The Pneumonia vaccine must have a long-lasting protection, and be of known legal/authorized brand in the Philippines

- Supply and Delivery of One (1) Lot: 10,000 units of 30 Wp Portable Solar Home Power System
- A. Instruction to Bidder Clause 5.3 SLCC:

Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No.9184, the Bidder shall have: one (1) similar contract within the last five (5) years with a contract amount of at least 50% of the ABC or at least two (2) similar contracts within the last five (5) years, the aggregate amount of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, should be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC for this Project; the largest of these similar contracts must be equivalent to at least 25% of the ABC



### B. Clarification on the IP65 Enclosure:

The solar charge control should be within the enclosure box and does not require IP65 rating.

The IP65 is also not a requirement for the enclosure box, it should only have a plug and play connection and should be tamper proof.
