**TO : ALL RENEWABLE PORTFOLIO STANDARDS (RPS) ON-GRID MANDATED PARTICIPANTS**

**DATE : 16 MARCH 2022**

**SUBJECT : SUBMISSION OF 2022 RPS REPORTORIAL REQUIREMENTS**

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This is in reference to the on-going implementation of the Department Circular (DC) No. DC2017-12-0015 entitled, "**Promulgating the Rules and Guidelines Governing the Establishment of the Renewable Portfolio Standards for On-Grid Areas,**" otherwise known as the "**RPS On-Grid Rules,**" which was made effective on 31 December 2017.

On 10 September 2021, the Department conducted the virtual Public Consultation on adopting the adjusted annual incremental RE percentage or the "Adjusted  $K_m$ ", increasing from 1% to 2.52% starting 2023, to meet the aspirational target of at least 35% in the total Power Generation Mix by 2030 and more than 50% by 2040.

Pending approval of the DC on adopting the Adjusted  $K_m$ , we enjoin all Mandated Participants to submit their individual 2022 RPS Requirement and Compliance Form with **minimum annual incremental RE percentage of 1%**. Kindly submit the following via electronic mail to [remb9513@doe.gov.ph](mailto:remb9513@doe.gov.ph) not later than 15 April 2022:

1. Actual data sets for period 2018-2021 and projections for planning period 2022-2030:
  - a. Net Electricity Sales, (less own-use);
  - b. Generation under Net-Metering Agreements, those installed within the premises of the end-users, and under the Green Energy Option Program (GEOP), if applicable; and
  - c. Supply Contract details.
2. Duly accomplished and signed copy (in PDF) of the 2022 RPS Form, attached hereto as Annex "A", and e-copy of the same (in excel file). Ensure all data entries are consistent with your respective 2022 Distribution Development Plan (DDP) submissions; and
3. Affidavit executed by the General Manager or any officer of equivalent rank. The said affidavit shall attest to the truthfulness and veracity of all data sets and information indicated in the 2022 RPS Form.

Failure to comply with this directive may result to applicable liabilities under Section 36 of the Republic Act No. 9513 and Sections 23 and 24 of the DC.
