



INTER-AGENCY ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND CONSERVATION COMMITTEE (IAEECC)

RESOLUTION NO. 10, s. 2024

Recommending to the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Harmonization of National Government Performance Monitoring, Information and Reporting Systems to Consider and Adopt Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EEC) as One of the Agency Accountabilities in the Grant of Performance-Based Bonus to National Government Agencies, Including Departments/Agencies, Other Executive Offices, Government-Owned or -Controlled Corporations (GOCCs) Under the Coverage of the Department of Budget and Management, Constitutional Offices, State Universities and Colleges, and Local Water Districts

WHEREAS, Republic Act (RA) No. 11285, or the Energy Efficiency and Conservation (EEC) Act, institutionalizes energy efficiency and conservation as a national way of life, enhances the efficient use of energy, and grants incentives to energy efficiency and conservation programs and projects;

WHEREAS, Section 43 of the Department of Energy (DOE) Department Circular No. DC2019-11-0014, the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the EEC Act (EEC Act-IRR), provides that the Government Energy Management Program (GEMP) shall cover all government agencies, including all departments, bureaus, offices, agencies, branches, and instrumentalities or political subdivisions, GOCCs, including their subsidiaries, other self-governing boards or commissions of the National Government, state universities, and colleges, and the local government units (LGUs), and authorizes the IAEECC to issue appropriate orders for the implementation of the GEMP;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the EEC Act states that the DOE shall take the lead in the implementation of the law, and shall be responsible for the planning, formulation, development, implementation, enforcement, and monitoring of energy management policies and other related energy efficiency and conservation plans and programs;

WHEREAS, Section 9 of the EEC Act establishes the IAEECC to, among others, evaluate and approve government energy efficiency projects, and provide strategic direction in the implementation of the GEMP;

WHEREAS, IAEECC Resolution No. 1, s. 2020 directs all government agencies to comply with the GEMP and orders the DOE to conduct energy audits, spot checks, technical analyses, and other research activities relative to energy efficiency projects of all government entities concerned;

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Administrative Order (AO) No. 25, s. 2011, created the Inter-Agency Task Force on the Harmonization of National Government Performance Monitoring, Information and Reporting Systems (AO25 IATF) which will harmonize, unify, streamline, and simplify all existing monitoring and reporting requirements and processes consistent with the Results-Based Performance Management System (RBPMS);

WHEREAS, Section 2 of AO No. 25, s. 2011, lays down the functions of the AO25 IATF to develop a common set of performance scorecard, design a Government Executive Information System, and other powers and functions as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of the abovementioned Administrative Order;

WHEREAS, Executive Order (EO) No. 80, s. 2012, directs the adoption of a Performance-Based Incentive (PBI) System consisting of the Productivity Enhancement Incentive (PEI) and the Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) in the national government beginning Fiscal Year (FY) 2012;

WHEREAS, under Section 8 of Executive Order No. 80, s. 2012, the Congress, Judiciary, Constitutional Commissions and the Office of the Ombudsman are encouraged to adopt the provisions of the Executive Order to be eligible for the grant of the PBB.

WHEREAS, EO No. 201, s. 2016 strengthens the Performance-Based Incentive System in recognition of government personnel who play a greater role and carry a heavier responsibility in attaining performance targets and delivering results, thereby enhancing the PBB;

WHEREAS, EEC is considered as an integral solution to cushion the volatility of energy cost, achieve energy security, and mitigate the threat of climate change; and

WHEREAS, Section 4.1 of DOE DO No. DO2020-01-0001 provides that the IAEECC shall act as a collegial body, and approval of its actions may be made by a simple majority;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the members of the IAEECC:

RESOLVED, that EEC shall be considered and included in the guidelines on the grant of the Performance-Based Bonus (PBB) as one of the Agency Accountabilities to encourage the whole national government to comply with the EEC Act and the GEMP, as well as foster EEC as a way of life;

RESOLVED, that the government entities' requirements and timeline on EEC compliance (attached as Annex A) shall be based on the EEC Act and EEC-IRR, GEMP, and all directives, advisories, issuances as well as resolutions of the IAEECC;

RESOLVED, that compliance with the abovementioned EEC requirements shall be used as a basis for determining the eligibility of responsible agencies/units and individuals for the grant of their annual PBB;

RESOLVED, that the said EEC set of requirements under this Resolution shall be endorsed to the Office of the Chairperson of the AO25 IATF for inclusion in the Agency Accountabilities in the grant of the PBB;

RESOLVED, that the DOE shall monitor the compliance with this Resolution and provide regular updates on the same to the IAEECC;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this Resolution be approved and disseminated to all agencies concerned for proper implementation; and

RESOLVED FINALLY, that this Resolution shall take effect upon publication in the Official Gazette or at least one (1) newspaper of general circulation. A copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the University of the Philippines Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register.
